The National Gallery collection has high calibre paintings from each of the four periods we will be looking at. We will select jewels from each period: the approach being more quality than quantity, depth rather than mileage covered.

Jeffery Courtney, a professional artist, will present a four module course, looking at paintings from an artist's point of view. Four fortnightly sessions at the National Gallery, London. Jeffery's style is interactive; discussion rather than lecturing. Focused but fun.



- We will begin with mediaeval art including the famous and exquisite Wilton Diptych.
- As we proceed through the Renaissance, 17th and 18th centuries we will see the development of ideas and techniques through the paintings of Botticelli, Leonardo da Vinci, Michelangelo, Titian, Rembrandt, Vermeer, Claude, Turner and Constable.
- Finally we will look at the masters of Impressionism and Post Impressionism: Monet, Pissarro, Cézanne, Van Gogh and others.

Jeffery trained at the RA Schools and has exhibited in many London galleries including the Royal Academy, Royal Society of Portrait Painters and Marylebone Gallery. He has work in many private collections and has fulfilled numerous commissions. Jeffery has made extensive study of painting techniques and has been commissioned to copy works by Leonardo, Rembrandt and many others. He helped design and paint the impressive fresco cycle at Waterperry House, Oxfordshire, and organised the painting section of the prestigious Art in Action festival for twelve years. Jeffery has also run many painting courses and given numerous talks and lectures on painting over the last forty
